



Environmental declaration (EMAS III)

In 2002, the Municipal Technical Services Department of Zarautz town hall began to implement the Environmental Management System (SGMA), in accordance with regulation UNE-EN ISO 14.001, for the services that it manages on the beach.

The town hall then decided that once the Environmental Management System had been consolidated on the beach, it would be an appropriate step forward to comply with the European regulation Eco-Management and Audit Scheme EMAS II, as it is more robust and establishes a greater relevance in the areas of communication and participation.

A resolution passed on the 27th of May 2004 by the Basque government's vice-minister for the environment, registered the Department of Municipal Technical Services of the Zarautz town hall (which is responsible for the management of the beach), on the EMAS register for environmental management and auditing. The EMAS register is an online database hosted by the European Commission, which lists all EMAS registered organisations and sites.
